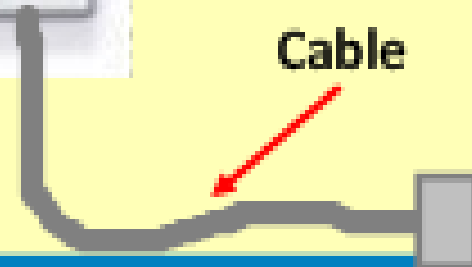

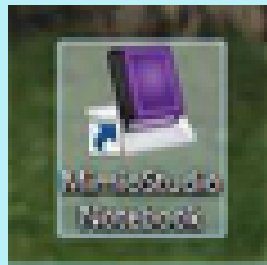

What is the Mimio?

Software

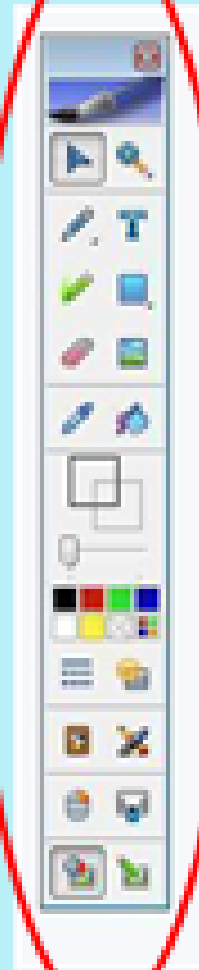
MimioStudio Notebook



- Presentation program
- **Tools** that can be used with other programs in conjunction with the interactive white board

MimioStudio Recorder

- Records your computer screen movements



How Can the Mimio Be Used?



- Create slides for presenting material
- Add elements to the slides that are interactive; use the stylus to manipulate information
- Tap into web based information by adding links within your Mimio presentation
- Play interactive games
- Access premade classroom lessons

How Can the Mimio Be Used?

- Add graphic organizers provided under the Gallery
- Embed online activities into your slideshow for easy access
 - Kahoot
 - Padlet
- Scan and add documents (alternative to doc camera)
- Use Mimio Tools in other programs

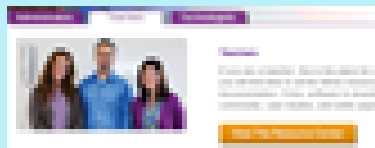

Using the MimioStudio at Home

1. Download MimioStudio onto your home computer. This will allow you to create and edit Mimio presentations at home.

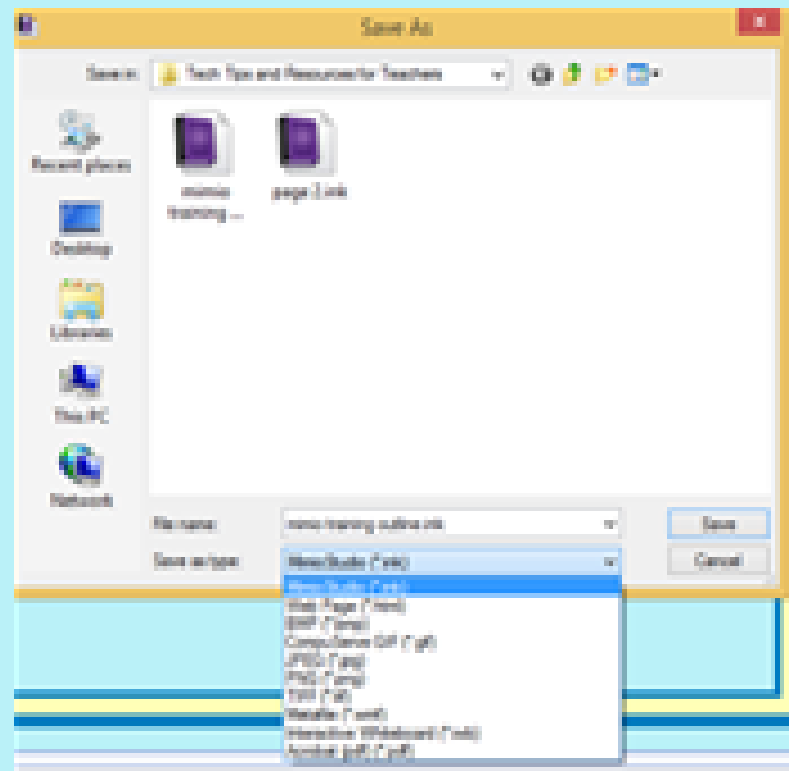

2. After you create your presentation, upload the MimioStudio file (.ink file) onto your Google Drive or email it to yourself for use at school.

3. Download the file you created at home onto your computer

Saving MimioStudio Files




- MimioStudio saves presentations in a **.ink** file format
- You can also save as HTML, BMP, GIF, JPEG, PNG, TIFF, WMF, IWB, PDF

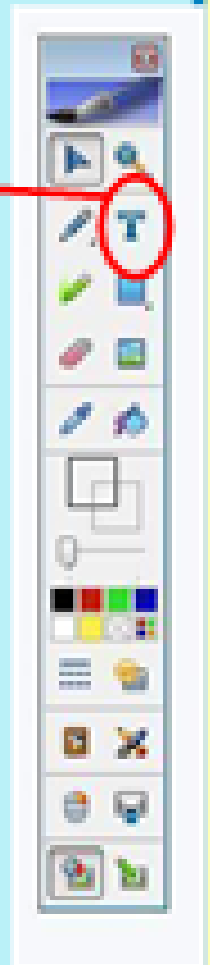
Mimio Tools: Tips



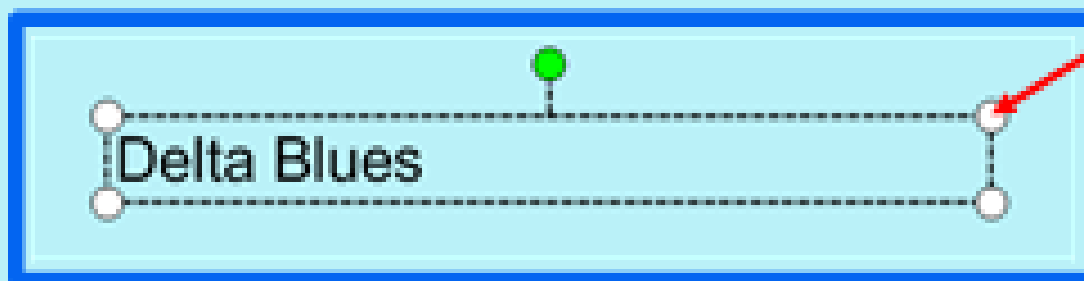
1. Watch how your pointer/cursor appears - it changes when you hover over items.
2. There is NO SPELL CHECK in MimioStudio
3. You can add text, images, lines, shapes to the slides.
4. Text and images are added within a box.
5. Each item or text box can be made into a hyperlink. Clicking on that item will launch a web browser and open the web site you have associated with that item or box.

Mimo Tools: Creating a Hyperlink to a Text Box

1. Create a Text Box
2. Click outside the text box
3. Right Click on the box, select Hyperlink or click the box and from the Insert Menu, select Hyperlink
4. Paste the URL address (<http://viewpure.com/f0K6RMLNXio>)
4. A big blue border will appear
5. To move or edit, rest on the text box until you see the 
6. Double click to open the text box and edit text. OR right click to edit hyperlink



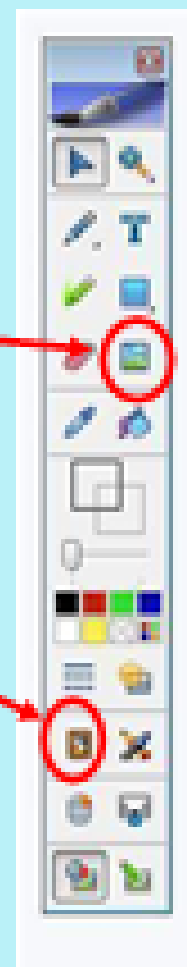
Confirm handles look like this before adding hyperlink

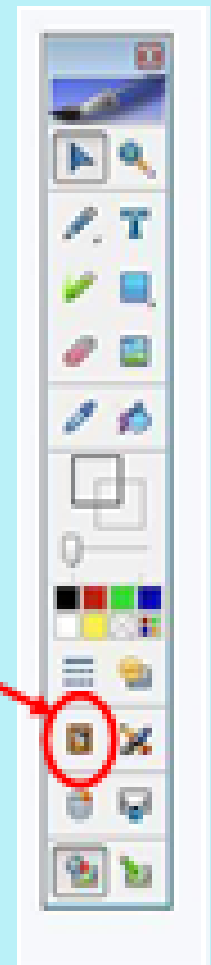
Creating a Hyperlink to An Image

1. Insert an Image
 - insert file
 - insert from Gallery
 - paste from clipboard
2. Click the image
3. Right Click, select Hyperlink or click the box and from the Insert menu, select Hyperlink
4. Paste the URL address
(<http://www.britannica.com/biography/Alex-Haley>)
5. A big blue border will appear



What is in the Gallery?

The Gallery contains information organized by subject area.



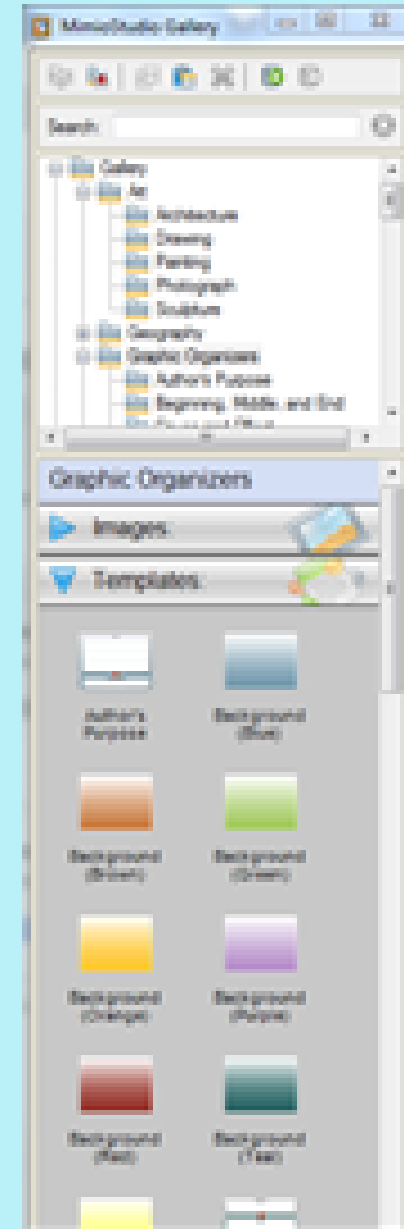
What is in the Gallery?

Information includes:

- Images
- Graphic Organizers
- Templates
- Multimedia

You can add your own images to the Gallery for future use:

- 1) Copy your image on your clipboard
- 2) Open the relevant Gallery list
- 3) Click on the image area and Paste.

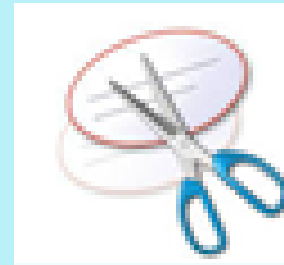

Troubleshooting the Mimio

1. If the light on the Mimio Teach is amber:
 - a. launch the Mimio Notebook
 - b. under Tools menu, Settings, Classroom Devices
 - c. on the MimioTeach, hold the amber button down for 20 seconds
 - d. the MimioTeach should appear under the Classroom Devices list.
 - e. Click the MimioTeach from this list and click "Connect". The light should turn green.

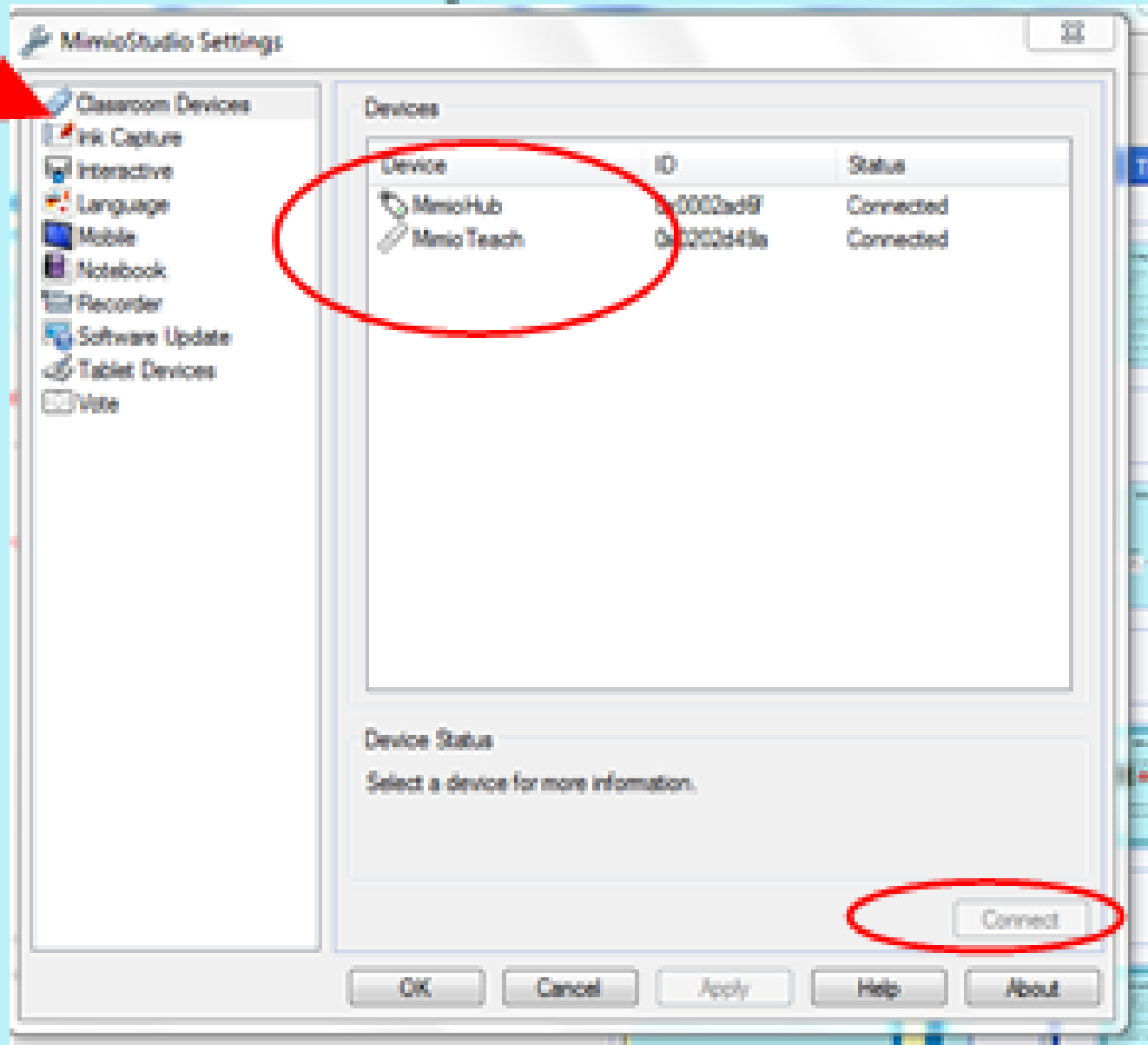

2. If the light on the Teach is green but the stylus is not registering, unplug the MimioHub and replug into the USB port on the PC.
 - a. (If needed, check under the Classroom Devices list to confirm the MimioHub is listed. If not, call for tech support.)
3. If the stylus is not registering in the correct spot, recalibrate the stylus (press the top button down on the Teach)
